In the Clerk's Office the 25 December 1824 This Indenture was made by Henry Stannard and Jacob Brantley both of the present heirs and contained in the Clerks office the 1st January 1825 This Indenture as of a sum acknowledged by them to be the party heirs and executors to said Andrew Cook her for the aforesaid County of Southampton on the 17th January 1825 This Indenture as aforesaid was made upon the following terms & conditions

This Indenture made this 1st day of October 1824 Between Cordale Brentley of the first part herein in behalf of the second part and Dorrington Ellis of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Whereas William Cordale Brentley doth acknowledge to Charles W. Briggs with sum of One hundred dollars and six pence and the said Dorrington Ellis becoming security for the forthcoming bond and also that said Cordale Brentley doth acknowledge to the said Charles W. Briggs for the sum of Eighty dollars and the said Ellis security to the original bond which there was last brought to Christopher C. Cook and said Cordale Brentley being willing and desirous to leave the said Dorrington Ellis property left or damage which he might sustain as security for the aforesaid Charles Brentley also for the final cancellation of the sum of one thousand dollars paid by the said Charles W. Briggs the receipt whereof the said Cordale Brentley doth hereby acknowledge and grants bargains and sells unto the said Charles W. Briggs an aforesaid one negro woman slave Betsy unto him the said Charles W. Briggs to him to do and to pay him from time to time what so ever shall be his true intent and meaning after present that the said Charles W. Briggs shall at any time after judgment after giving ten days notice at the Court House door of this County Justice of the peace of the said Dorrington Ellis or the said Cordale Brentley cause to be sold the aforesaid negro woman and of the money arising from such sale pay and satisfy the aforesaid debts arrears and all other costs which may accrue thereto the cost of his indenture and the expenses of any lawyer retained by Cordale Brentley or expenses as he may determine in writing before the parties to this present have recourse to their hands and sell the day and year above written.

To Marshallmanly these presents shew I Petercau Applegate of the County of Southampton for and upon account of the natural love and affection which I bear to Petercau Applegate of the aforesaid County was willing for the better Consideration of you to leave to me in trust paid by the said Petercau Applegate to me before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is fully acknowledged here given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Petercau Applegate his executors administrators and assigns one negro woman named Franky under all her further neede to have and to hold the said Franky with her effects immured unto her by said Petercau Applegate to her executors administrators and assigns for and during Petercau Applegate's life herself her executors administrators and assigns the said Franky unto the said Petercau Applegate to be her executors administrators and assigns against the claim of her the said Petercau Applegate to be sold by any assign and against the claim or claims of alread and every person whatsoever sole and all manner and former debtors by these presents.
