To James Clement and the 23<sup>d</sup> day of November 1824 between James Clement of the first part and Jeph. Holt of the second part and Edmund B. Clark of the third  
part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Attorneys at law wherein he servs. James Clement stands hereby witness to the true Impost of  
the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars and six cent of the said James Clement being at the 23<sup>d</sup> day of November 1824 for the sum of one hundred and fifty  
Dollars and six cent of the County of Virginia and being willing and desirous to secure the sum aforesaid to the said Jeph. Holt in consideration whereof and  
monition given and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and five Dollars paid the receipt whereof is being acknowledged the said James Clement hath given  
and granted and sold and by these presents doth give and sell and make over unto the said James Clement Edmund B. Clark  
his heirs & to him the following property to wit Negroes Manuel and Barbara To have and to hold the said property unto the said Edmund  
B. Clark his heirs and assigns forever at a rent of twelve Dollars per annum and payment for the support purpose of paying the said  
Jeph. Holt the said sum of One hundred and fifty dollars and six cent to the said James Clement stands made expost wherein it is  
stated agreed and admitted to be the true intent and meaning of this Indenture that the said sum before specified be and punctually  
paid unto the said Jeph. Holt each and instant when or before the 23<sup>d</sup> day of November 1825 then the said Jeph. Holt shall be  
at full liberty at any time thereafter when it may seeme to him due the said debt or any part thereof still remaining to require and  
compel the said Edmund B. Clark to take unto his service the said property as per his directions and after advertising the  
time and place of sale for at least ten days at their publick places convenient to the said value of the said James Clements  
to sell for ready money the said property to whomsoever it may seeme to him fit and the said Edmund B. Clark shall have power & discretion to  
make over or transfer a lawful right and title to the purchase of the property and the said James Clements his heirs  
and assigns shall be forever estopped from setting up any claim to the same either in law or equity from such  
sale first to be applied to the payment of the said sum due the said Jeph. Holt with all interest and costs attorney occurring  
and the balance of any so applied to the said James Clements his heirs & to the person or persons entitled to receive the  
same by the statute of descent or provided aforesaid and to whomsoever that of the said James Clements pay the said  
sum of money with all interest and costs thereon at any time before the property be sold in manner as mentioned before  
then this Indenture to be void and all right and title herein contained shall revert to the said James  
Clement his heirs and assigns forever In testimony whereof the said James Clements Jeph. Holt and Edmund  
B. Clark have set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first written
