Thence down to the line of Goldberry's land thence along the same to the State line to the Muskegon River thence down the river to the first station together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Collier H. Barnes his heirs and assigns forever. Upon Trust mutually and for the uses intents and purposes agreed between the parties that the said Collier H.
