This Indenture as of course was executed as aforesaid were called upon the present day.

This Indenture made and entered into this 25th day of September in the year of our Lord Christ 1824 in and between
Dear Gardner of Southampton County Virginian of the first part Gardner and Samuel Daugthery of the
Edward Williams County and State of the second part and Simon Miller of the same County and State of the third part witness
that whereas the said Dear Gardner on the 2^d day of September 1824 executed a note in certain amount due for the
sum of Seventy five dollars and Eighty three cents and made payable to me after rates and fees for the payment of
the said note the above named Dear Gardner and Samuel Daugthery to cover the same of him he has and doth
Gardner know the said Edward Williams long accustomed to sedentary and leisure life his ministering life
likewise especially for the sum of one year to him and paid before the execution of and delivery of this present of him to
said Simon Miller he receipt whereof he hereby acknowledge to the said Dear Gardner shall be paid and bargained
and sold and delivered by the present grant bargained and sold to him the said Simon Miller his heirs and assigns
forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being within County of Southampton and town of Southwicks
of Hertford parish and bounded by the lands of Capt. Gardner and Samuel Daugthery and Stephen D.
Holland. Now the said Dear Gardner doth for him self his heirs and assigns every person or persons
whatsoever will and doth warrant and defend all right title and interest in the said tract of land to him
the said Simon Miller his heirs and assigns forever upon the following trust w^t If the above named Dear Gardner
shall fail to pay and discharge the above aforesaid cost pertaining to the Execution of this shall be compelled to pay
to Simon Miller shall be commenced against the said Edward Gardner and Samuel Daugthery for the payment
of the above mentioned debt that the said Simon Miller to have as regards an action from under the hand of
them the said Edward Gardner and Samuel Daugthery or either of them their heirs or assigns to set up and
sell the above mentioned tract of land for cash after giving public notice by advertisement to be set up at
different publick places in the neighborhood at least ten days before the day of sale and out of the money
so raised pay the above debt and all costs pertaining to this trust and the surplus of any pay over to him
the said Dear Gardner his heirs and assigns in settling which the parties have set me cause
