This Indenture made this 14th day of February in the year of our Lord Christ 1825
by and between Jonathan Lester of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and in the parish of
Nottingham the one part and Joseph Slampy of the same County State and parson of the other part witnesseth
that the said Jonathan Lester for and consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars good and lawful
money of Virginia which he paid by the said Joseph Slampy the receipt whereof he said
Jonathan Lester doth acknowledge himself fully and owing thereof and payment granted
thereon doth alreadys suffice and sufficient to the said Joseph Slampy to him and to his
heirs & successors in the said tract of Land and premises known by the name of Newmarket
lying and being in the County State and aforesaid containing namely now a eas to the said
runneth and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a post oak a corner between John Lawrence's estate line
thence N.E. 10 1/4 P pole to a post tree of a post oak a corner between John Lawrence's estate line thence N.W. 1/2 P pole to a pine standing in
