William Newson and Nancy Newson his wife for and consideration of the sum of one hundred and ten
dollars Current money of the Commonwealth of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Matthew Tuck
above before the making and delivery of these presents do receipt acknowledge and acknowledge the same
Received and paid and by these presents do grant bargaine and sell unto the said Matthew
Tuck and his heirs forever on certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being within a certain
County of Southampton and part of Saint Luke & containing by a recent survey forty three acres
to the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a black Gum a corner tree to
the River Wading said Tree hew 8^{ft} 8ⁱⁿ poles there 9^{ft} 16ⁱⁿ poles down 8^{ft} 8ⁱⁿ poles to a pine tree
8^{ft} 8ⁱⁿ poles to a black Gum corner of Eason Ticks or Common Woods here along said Eason Ticks
