This Indenture made the 12th day of July 1721 between William Everett and Maria a Law
of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Clement Pochell of the same
County and State of the other part. Wherefore that the said William L. Everett and Maria the wife
for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars current money of Virginia well by
them received good large and full value and worth and by these presents hath granted bargained sold
conveyed and confirmed unto the said Clement Pochell to him and to his heirs forever in certain tract or
pieces of land and premises being the land depicted between us situated lying and being within
County of said Southhampton by estimation out here due and pay made for the same money
and toward as follows to wit beginning at a Perchman First standing was small board
in between a Carabin on the side of the Station Road thence along said road toward said Everetts
a large pine a new Carabin standing on the side of the road thence along a line of four miles to
at 70 to be the old line formerly between Clement Pochells and said William L. Everett thence
along the old line northward toward Carabin to between a Stone line thence down said line margin
in westerly Course to the perpendicular bar at the road the first beginning which being the bound on the west
of said land between the docters road and Clement Pochells old line also the bound or part of land
lying on the opposite side of the road as follows to wit beginning at a large red oak in said Pochells
old line it being a corner tree between Davis Poyants land and the best land now purchased there
along a line of marked trees between Davis Poyants land and the land now purchased a north
Course to the run of the Cypress Swamp thence down the current Course of said Swamp to a cut tree
now corner between the said Clement Pochell and William L. Everett thence along a line of four
marked trees a South Course to a white oak being Abrams Octains in the said Pochells old line
thence along the old line a west Course to the red oak being Poyants corner the first beginning together
with all houses out houses edifices buildings yards gardens orchards ways waters and water courses
whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining to the best tract or parcel of Land now purchased
to have and to hold the same unto the said Clement Pochell to him and to his heirs forever
and the said William L. Everett and Maria the wife forthwithless their heirs Executors
administrators or assigns shall by these presents Covenant and grant to and with the said
Clement Pochell his heirs and assigns that they will count out and forever defend all right
title claim or demand of any person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part
or parts thereof to the wife of the said William L. Everett and Maria to her wife and heirs and
their heirs and unto the day and date above written
