This Indenture made this 12th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty five between Elias Beale
and Lydia his wife both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Richard
Bull their Son of the same County and State of the other part witnesseth that the said Elias Beale and Lydia his
wife for and in consideration of the just and full sum of one hundred and forty six dollars and twenty seven cents money of
the United States of America by the said Richard Bull to him and his heirs forever the receipt whereof is acknowledged
doth. Beale and Lydia his wife do hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said Richard Bull his
heirs and assigns forever and themselves herewith fully and entirely released and paid the said Elias
Beale and Lydia his wife have gone to California unexpired released between Oregon and California
and by these presents do grant lay and sell over unexpired release same deliver and confirm unto the said Richard
Beale and his heirs and assigns forever all that plantation tract or parcel of land wherein the said Elias Beale
now lives and being all the land now belonging to any one to the said Elias Beale in Southampton County
aforesaid containing by estimation eighty three acres to the same more or less bounded by the known and
existing boundaries of and all the houses out houses dependencies buildings wood ways waters and water courses
gardens orchards profits Conveniences hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in any
wise appertaining and the reversion hereunder rents profits therefrom all the estate right title interest
claim and demand of the said Elias Beale and Lydia his wife of or unto to the same to have and to hold to
the said plantation tract or parcel of eighty three acres of land and premises well and at ease unto the said Elias
Beale and Richard Beale his heirs and assigns forever to the only purpose and intent of
the said Richard Beale his heirs and assigns forever and the said Elias Beale and Lydia his wife for
themselves their heirs executors and administrators the said plantation and tract of land of whom ever
with the appurtenances forever unto the said Richard Beale and to his heirs and assigns against
the said Elias Beale and Lydia his wife their heirs executors administrators and assigns and against
any other person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof
shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents On this 12th day of February in the year
one thousand eight hundred and thirty two given in witness set their hands and affixed thereto seal
