This Indenture made last entered into this 10th day of March in the Year 1805 between Richard P. Briggs and Maule L. Briggs his wife of the County of Grant in the State of Virginia of the first part and Pys Sumner of the aforesaid County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard P. Briggs and Maule L. Briggs for and in consideration of the Sum of One thousand and twenty dollars (Twenty money of Virginia) to them in hand paid by the said Pys Sumner the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Allan G. Baldwin and John Compton and by their privates do grant Pay and Sell and Convey unto the said Pys Sumner all their right title interest property claim and demand whatsoever which they the said Richard P. Briggs and Maule L. Briggs now have or hereafter may have of or to a certain piece parcel or part of Land containing three hundred and twenty acres more or less which was divided and appraised to said Pys Sumner by John Thomas late Auditor and Clerk of the said County of Grant deceased in the Land of his late husband the said Henry Briggs deceased for and for his share and to hold the aforesaid interest in the aforesaid premises unto the said Pys Sumner his heirs and assigns forever and the said Richard P. Briggs and Maule L. Briggs do for themselves their heirs executors and assigns forever warrant and defend the right and title of him and to the aforesaid John Thomas parcel of Land according to their interest unto the said Pys Sumner his heirs and assigns forever against them their heirs executors and assigns and against all and every person or persons whomsoever.
