This Indenture made this 17 day of March on the said eighth hundred and twenty four between Archibald  
 Drake of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part James Stott of the said County of  
 State of the second part and Escha Lewis of the said County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the third part  
 witnesseth that whereas the said Archibald Drake desired justly satisfaction by a writ of habeas to the said James  
 Stott in the sum of two hundred and fifty seven dollars and ten cents current money of the aforesaid State of  
 Virginia and whereas for the further appearance of the payment of a agreed between the parties hereto the  
 Convention a trust shall be made to the said Escha Lewis for the benefit of the said James Stott of the  
 sum on the note of hand aforesaid shall not be punctually paid with lawfull interest thereon on  
 before the first day of August next Then the indenture witnesseth that the said Archibald Drake for and  
 in consideration of the premises and for the further sum of one dollar to him in hand paid the receipt
