This Indenture made and entered into this the seventeenth day of January 1825 by and between Matthew Beck and Patience his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and in the lower district of Saint Luke's parish of the one part and Edwin Beck of the same County and State and in the parish of the like name of the other that the said Matthew Beck and Patience his wife for an express recitation of the sum of one hundred dollars and forty dollars Current money to them in hand paid by the said Edwin Beck on or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they do sayd Matthew Beck and Patience his wife doth hereby acknowledge themselves therewith fully satisfied Contented and paid have granted bargained and sold to the said Edwin Beck and his heirs and assigns his certain improvements parts or parcels of land lying and being in the County and parish aforesaid containing the number of acres of land set aside by Conveyances for the use of her the said Patience Beck to hold and occupy during her life as a widow or widow right in the lands of her deceased husband Samuel Beck containing by Survey fifty seven acres in one tract and sixteen and two hundredths other tract together with all houses and houses belonging thereto and profits thereunto belonging or in any way appertaining To her and to hold the said bounded premises with the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any way appertaining unto the only profession of him the said Edwin Beck his heirs and assigns during the life of her the said Patience Beck widow of him the said Samuel Beck deceased and after of him the said Matthew Beck and Patience and jointly her the said Matthew Beck and Patience his wife will by these presents warrant and cause defendant to her the said Edwin Beck his heirs and assigns against the lawful claim or claims of all persons claiming by or through them the said Matthew Beck and Patience his wife In witness whereof hands he d.
