This Indenture made this 20th day of December 1723 between James Scott of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Debra Lewis of the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said James Scott for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to him in hand paid by the said Debra Lewis and fifty dollars and fifty four cents cash and money and had paid the receipt whereof is hereby attested copy hath and made by these presents doth sell unto the said Debra Lewis and to her heirs and assigns all that plantation tract and parcel of land in the County of Southampton aforesaid which Henry Chesny and others Clergy Clergy and Confessors made the said James Scott by a deed in trust to secure the payment of a debt due to Ann Better bearing date the twenty eighth day of April 1720. Containing by estimation thirty four acres be the same more or less and bounded by the aforesaid and did in trust conveyed and declared to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land unto the said Debra Lewis and her heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Debra Lewis her heirs and assigns forever and the said James Scott his heirs executors and assigns the said tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Debra Lewis her heirs and assigns against himself the said tract James Scott his heirs executors and assigns and against every other person claiming or assuming the same from her by or under him shall and will remain and to forever remain by these presents in full and whole whereof the said James Scott hath herunto set his hand and seal the day and year first above written signed sealed and delivered in presence of

This Indenture made the day of January in the year 1725 between Jesse Parker Trustee of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the one part and Hardy Croft of the County of Henrico in the State of Virginia of the other part witnesseth that the said Jesse Parker for and in consideration of the sum of seventy seven dollars to him in hand paid by the said Hardy Croft at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby attested copy to the said Jesse Parker as Trustee hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Hardy Croft his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton on the East Side of Northony river Containing one hundred acres more or less (it being the tract of land which Jordan Betterman purchased from Richard Murphy which is duly and regularly conveyed to the said Jordan Betterman by deed of bargain and sale from said Murphy and duly his wife bearing date the 17th day of March 1721 and by a deed of trust of the same date the said tract or parcel of land and was conveyed to the said Jesse Parker as Trustee aforesaid for purposes therein expressed which will more fully appear by reference to the records of Southampton County aforesaid the most correct returns thereon and returns of yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances thereto and all and singular the premises and appurtenances herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof unto the said Hardy Croft his heirs and assigns forever on and about the said Jesse Parker for him self and his heirs the said tract or parcel of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Hardy Croft his heirs and assigns free from the claims of him the said Jesse Parker his heirs and assigns and of all and every person or persons whatsoever by the said Jesse Parker as Trustee aforesaid or by his heirs and assigns and forever by these presents in full and whole whereof the said Jesse Parker hath herunto set his hand and seal the day and year first above written signed sealed and delivered in presence of
