one iron bed gear one gun two sets on two oval one on square pan one pair flat irons two horns one

new and 10 years of land whereon the said Peale now lives and bounded by the well known lines
of John Spicers land & Billing. At Samuel land and Augustina. To wit land to wit the same more or
less land being the same more or less as the said Wm. C. Peale and to his heirs and assigns
forever and for the following subject uses and purposes Viz he the said Wm. C. Peale has expressed
this may and shall at any time hereafter being required by such parties to whom presents proceed to sell
at public sale for ready money all or so much of said land and property as will be sufficient
to pay and satisfy the amount of each of the within mentioned debts and so permit that any
person therein in this case that the said Wm. C. Peale shall give bonds and put in some notice
of the sale of said property by publically advertising the same. The Wm. C. Peale and assigns not of said
parties have bound themselves to do and affirm their state this day and year as well as to the
