and State of Virginia witnesseth that whereas the said Allen Brat. hath heretofore partly indebted
to the said Augustine Tpke in several instances by way of bond bearing record as with these presents
on the sum of forty eight dollars and fifty eight cents also another bond due the first day of July
last on the sum of Two hundred and thirty three dollars. Now this indenture further witnesseth
that the said Allen Brat. being willing and desirous for discharging the said Augustus Tpke the
said debts and growing interest thereon and also for and consideration of the sum of one hundred
thousand pounds paid by the said Wm. Tpke hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents
doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Wm. Tpke and to his heirs and assigns forever the following
and particularly trust his feather bed and furniture one chest two tables one wooden washstand
one iron washstand gear one Gunbarrel pot one duck over one fowling piece one pair of steel arms two horses one
bullock and colt one feed barrel one iron and two pigs one broad axe and two marron guns also thirty
men and 100 acres of land wherein and thereon lies and bounded by the said known lines
of John Dryerland Tpke, M. Barnes land and Augustus Tpke land formerly James
Bartons land being the same more or less to the said Wm. Tpke and to his heirs and assigns
forever and for the following just and lawful purposes by the said Wm. Tpke to represent
this may and shall at any time hereafter being required by said Tpke to whom presents proceed to all
at publick sale for ready money all or so much of land and property as will be sufficient
to pay and satisfy the amount of each of the within mentioned debts and costs and expenses that may
occur thereon in this case that the said Wm. Tpke shall give ten days previous notice
of the date of his paying by publicly advertising the same by writing whereof and of said
parties have herunto set their hands and affixed this date this day and year well written
