This Indenture made this 3rd day of December 1824 between James Turner a Freeman of the said  
of the first part Party Bryant of the second part and James Rodelle of the third part testifying that  
whereas the said James Turner stands greatly indebted unto the said Party Bryant by several bills bearing  
date the second day of September next for the sum of one hundred dollars which may be discharged  
by the payment of fifty dollars and also by James Turner being willing and  
desirous to secure the payment of the aforesaid debt and all interest which may become due thereon  
hereafter and in consideration of the premium aforesaid and more especially for and consideration of  
the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid and granted bargained and sold and by these presents  
doth grant bargain and sell unto the said James Rodelle one tenth of all my more and less  
Chattels and goods whatsoever property and every part thereof unto him the said James Rodelle  
to have and to hold from the date of this Indenture and confirmed that it is my intent and desire  
that he shall pay the aforesaid debt when the same shall become due thereafter he  
shall further for the said James Rodelle to make sale of the aforesaid property or to much thereof as will  
be sufficient to pay and satisfy the sum and all costs interest and charges accrued thereon  
and out of the proceeds of the said sale pay and satisfy the same debt interest and costs and the rest  
thereof pay to the said James Turner his heirs executors and administrators and the said James Turner for  
himself his heirs executors and administrators and defend the right and title to the aforesaid against  
himself his heirs executors and administrators and against all and every person or persons whomsoever. In witness

of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and James Taylor of the aforesaid County  
and State of the other part witnesseth that the said Benjamin Blunt for and consideration of the  
sum of seven hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said James Taylor on or before the concluding  
and delivery of this present the receipt whereof he hereby acknowledge to have long since had and by  
these presents doth give grant bargain sell deliver and confer unto the said James Taylor his heirs  
and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton  
Containing by estimation one hundred and eighty one acres to be the same more or less being the land  
whereon Richard Blunt did at one time stand. I further do of myself my hands and by the hands of Anthony Woodard now a son  
of the lands of Richard Edmunds John Bay died the down lands of Mary Ann Bay and my own lands  
together with all woods underwoods houses waters and waters courses and all the appurtenances thereto  
belonging or in any way therunto appertaining to the property and behalf of the said James  
Taylor his heirs and assigns forever and I the said Benjamin Blunt do for myself my heirs  
and assigns warrant and defend the just right and title of these aforesaid lands and  
possessions unto the aforesaid James Taylor being my son the said James Taylor the heir and  
assigns forever to be free and clear from all lawful claims or demands of myself or person whatever  
as holder of my land and seal the day and date above written signed sealed and delivered in presence  
of Party Bryant James C. West James Edwards
