This Indenture made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen between Robert Archer of the first and Augustine Lopez of the second, both and wife of the third partite of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that whereas the said Augustine Lopez hath been bound by him for the sum of £1000.00 sterling or a debt due by him to Dr. John Marshall for the sum of £1000.00 dollars to him until payment and also with their present action another debt due to said Augustine Lopez by him on the sum of £1000.00 dollars bearing even date with their present action and further witnesseth that the said Robert Archer being desirous and desirous of securing the said Augustine Lopez on the said £1000.00 dollars and also for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him on hand paid by the said Robert Archer for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him on hand paid by the said Robert Archer and also by them present both grant bargains and sell unto the said Robert Lopez and to his heirs and assigns forever the following property to-wit the further bed and furniture now written whereon set out and are set out in the following manner on Table hereunder Told two pounds two shillings three pence and four farthings of threys to the said Robert Lopez and to his heirs and assigns forever and to the following interest and purpose by him the said Robert Lopez or his representatives may and shall at any time hereafter being requested by either of the parties to their present hands to let and suffer to pay and satisfy each of the above mentioned debts interest and expenses that may accrue thereon in the County of Southampton before the said Robert Lopez shall give ten days' previous notice of said property, publick advertising of the same in a Writing wherein each of the said parties to their present hands have herunto set their hands and affix their seals this day and date wherein written.

This Indenture made this 18<sup>th</sup> day of January 1525 between Ephraim Elliott of the County of Devon  
and Isle of South Hamsire of the one part and Iane Garder of the County of Warwicke and late aforesaid  
of the other part witnesseth that the said Ephraim Elliott for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred  
and thirty three dalears and delivery there and on demand to have and to be paid at or before the anniversary  
and delivery of these presents the receipt and payment he doth hereby acknowledge have given and bargained and so  
alured and Convinced unto him the said Iane Garder his tenement and aposse one certain tract or parcel of  
Land lying and beinge in the County of Tuckamore and Containing by a late Survey beinge given as  
sayng the lot of land apperteyning to him in right of his late wife Agnes who was formerly hys wif that  
in the tenure of the Lands of William Shand or else where fully apperteing by the report of the Compt  
comer fles in the Clerke Office of the County Court of Tuckamore who aches under a seale of the  
said County Court to have and to have the said Land bargained premised hys conveyed to him the said Iane Garder Sd  
his tenement and aposse forever by him with all and singular the appurtenances heretofore and now hereto to  
the same belonging or in any way apperteyning and I the said Ephraim Elliott with knowyng of my  
heirs executors and administrators and defend agred and perfid right and title unto him the  
said Iane Garder his tenement and aposse against the claimes or claimes of any person or persons what  
ever. In witness whereof I the said Ephraim Elliott have hereunto set my hand and affyd my  
seale the day and year date above written signed execgated Ephraim Elliott

experience of Edwin & Mark Reddick Griffin Esq & Sons  
Stockhampton, Devon. In the former office the 11 April 1835 their son was found by the side  
of Edwin & Mark Reddick Esq & Sons and Benjamin Brett the carpenter who admitted to and  
and at a court held for the said Esq & Sons of Exmouth, on the 18 May 1835 that  
Indicture as before was entered upon him for murder of his son
