Therefore we do give to you power to receive the acknowledgement which the said Bartholemew Brown shall be willing to make before you of the conveyance contained in the said instrument which he has annexed. And we do further command you to go privately to the said Bartholemew Brown and recover her a true or legament of the same and examine her privately and apart from her husband whether she hath recd the said land freely and voluntarily without the persuasion or entice of her husband and whether she is willing the said husband should be recorded in the County Court of our said County and when you have examined her as aforesaid and be satisfied of the said instrument that you distinctly and openly certify under your hands and seals returning to us at this court with the said deed annexed witness Southampton County of this County at this office the 15th day of November 1821. Griffitt is now willing to leave the said Jonathan T. Griffitts estate that he and in consideration of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said Jonathan T. Griffitts by the said Benjamin Griffitt as aforesaid the making this above of them presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Jonathan T.
