

This Indenture made and entered into the 25th day of May in the year of our Lord 1525 between Lefse Drury of the first part and J. Joseph Drury of the second part both of the County of Southampton and Isle of Wight in Whiche that whereas the said Joseph Drury did on the 15th day of July 1525 execute headed to the said Lefse Drury an acknowledgment in writing that on the 15th day of July 1525 he had received to the said Lefse Drury a certain sum of money therein expressed owing by him the said Joseph Drury to a certain Henry J. Wombrook of Wiltshire the which conveyed in trust to the said Joseph Drury a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton on the north side of a highway river and the said sum therein mentioned having been fully paid by the said Joseph Drury to the said Henry J. Wombrook and William Sticheu &c the said Joseph Drury had requested that the whole conveyed by the said deed should be to him the said Lefse Drury in the said ground he now retained to him the said Joseph Drury Thus Indentures therefore executed that for and in consideration of the premises and also for and in consideration of one dollar by the said Joseph Drury to the said Lefse Drury in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of this present indenture which is hereby acknowledged by the said Lefse Drury by and with the consent of Henry J. Wombrook and William Sticheu have granted granted released and forever quit claim unto the said Joseph Drury his heirs and assigns forever all the estate right title interest property claim and debt and whatsoever in Law or equity of him the said Joseph Drury of record to the said parcel of land with the appurtenances to have and to hold the aforesaid tract of land with the appurtenances unto the said Joseph Drury his heirs and assigns to have and to enjoy the same and behoof of the said Joseph Drury his heirs and assigns forever so that the said Lefse Drury nor his heirs assigns shall claim under him shall by any way or means hereafter have claim challenge or demand and any estate right title or interest of mine to the said premises
