This Indenture made and entered into this 16th day of May 1732 between Joseph Drury and Emily his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and Thomas Fitzhugh of the aforesaid County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Joseph Drury for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and eighty dollars to him the said Joseph Drury in hand paid by the said Thomas Fitzhugh (the receipt whereof the said Joseph Drury doth hereby acknowledge) hath granted bargained sold and conveyed by these presents grant bargain and sell convey and Confirm unto the said Thomas Fitzhugh and his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and on the north side of a stream never Containingly recent survey two hundred and thirty acres be the same more or less reference being had to the report of the Commissioners who were appointed by the County Court of Southampton to divide the lands of John James deceased and which land was attested to the heirs of the said John James deceased fully appear to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to have the said Thomas Fitzhugh his heirs and assigns forever and the said Joseph Drury for himself his heirs executors and administrators do hereby Covenant and agree with and unto the said Thomas Fitzhugh his heirs and assigns that he the said Joseph Drury his heirs and assigns the said tract or parcel of land with its appurtenances unto have the said Thomas Fitzhugh his heirs and assigns against him the said Joseph Drury his heirs and assigns and against all persons and persons whomsoever shall come by these presents forever warrant and defend In testimony whereof the said Joseph Drury have hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and date first recited
