This Indenture made and entered into this 23 day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and twenty five between Thomas Trotter and Jane Trotter his wife of the first part and
John T. Trotter acting on the Commission of the peace in and for the County of Southampton
Commonwealth of Virginia Whereas by an order of the County Court of the said County of Southampton
made at the aforesaid term thereof instant according to the provisions of the act of Assembly in such
case made and provided Chap. Lawkford Act. Barnes and John Thomas Esq: are of opinion
and to contract with the said Thomas Trotter for the purchase of a certain parcel of land
land herein after more fully and particularly described at the price and for the purpose stated
and referred to in the aforesaid order and between the said John T. Trotter & Joseph Barnes and
Jno. Thomas have discharged the duties required by them by contracting with the said Thomas
Trotter for the purchase and conveyance of the said tract of land so far as the summons
concerned. This Indenture therefore witnesseth that for and consideration of the sum of
fifteen hundred and fifty eight dollars of you and lawful money of the Commonwealth
aforesaid to be paid to him in three equal annual instalments with interest therefrom the
date hereof by the said County Court of Southampton he the said Thomas Trotter and
Jane Trotter his wife have granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grant
bargain and sell unto the Gentleman for this sum a copy of the Commission of the peace
in and for the County aforesaid and to their successors in office as such legally appointed and
commissioned for or on certain parcels of land black and lying in the County
