This Indenture made this 28 day of May 1825 between Thomas James and Sally his wife of the  
County of Southampton of the one part and Aaron Storckfort of the County of Suffolk part ditto of the  
State of New York the wife for and consideration of the sum of five hundred  
and twenty six dollars current money of Virginia the receipt whereof the said Thomas James and  
and Sally his wife doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold and confirmed unto the said Aaron  
Storckfort and to his heirs and assigns forever all that tract of land and premises  
with all appurtenances situated and lying and being in the County of Southampton  
Containing by estimation one hundred acres more or less and bounded as follows to wit  
Beginning at a tree oak a corner between James Stanton Aaron Storckfort and Thomas  
James thence down the said tract to the flat swamp shore along the  
Swamp to Benjamin Blunt's line to the corner between the said Aaron Storckfort  
Benjamin Blunt and Thomas James shore along the said line to a white birch tree  
thence along the carriage road to the said Aaron Storckfort's line the aforesaid one hundred  
acres of land being a part of a tract of land now on the top of the said Thomas  
James. To have and to hold the aforesaid land with all houses and houses thereon  
ways and courts with all other rights franchises profits committies and advantages  
whatsoever to the said said Belonging or in any way appertaining unto him the said Aaron  
Storckfort his heirs and assigns forever in as full and ample manner to all his intents and  
purposes as I do hereby Covenant promise and grant to and with the said Aaron
