and consideration of the sum of four hundred and twenty nine dollars and twenty four
cents which said sum is due from the said Nicholas D. Williams to the said Henry Briggs
by note bearing date the 18th day of March 1823 as well as all other monies which might be owing
from the said Nicholas D. Williams to the said Henry Briggs by means of any dealings
to wit of debts or proper collection as also for and consideration of one dollar to him
in hand paid by the said Edward Butts the receipt whereof the said Nicholas D.
Williams doth hereby acknowledge grant his heirs and assigns and his heirs and assigns

do hereby grant bargain and sell convey and make over unto the said Edward Butts and his
heirs forever all his right and interest in the following property to wit Company Henry
and Mary Slaves and the further services of the female slave belonging to him the
said Nicholas D. Williams to have and to hold with all the right and interest of the
said Edward Butts and his heirs and assigns forever upon this special trust now chief that the
said Edward Butts upon being thereof required by the said Edward Butts shall
procure to sell all the right and interest of the said Nicholas D. Williams to the above
named slaves hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed after advertising the same for sale
in the said County of Southampton for ten days previous at some public house in the
for cash and out of the money arising out of the said sale on the first day of
May and satisfy all and alter duty the said sale as well as the expenses attending the
