This Indenture made this 19th day of March in the year of our Lord 1825 between Rebecca Applewhite Henry Applewhite and Saml his wife of the one part and Benjamin Applewhite of the other part Witnesseth that the said Rebecca Applewhite Henry Applewhite and Saml his wife for and in consideration of the sum of twenty four hundred and thirty one dollars to them in hand paid by the said Benjamin Applewhite above separated (caveating) and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof a being acknowledged the said Rebecca Applewhite Henry Applewhite and Saml his wife do hereby acknowledge that they have sold conveyed aliened and confirmed and each by their presents grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Benjamin Applewhite his heirs execs and admors forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Somerset containing four hundred and seven more or less of being the land whereon the said Henry Applewhite now lives on the South side of the three Cretes and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a fixed gun on the South of said Cret a corner between the said Henry Applewhite and Henry J. Westbrook thence along the line to a black oak a corner on said Westbrook and Andrew Smith thence along the said Smith line to a post oak a corner on the said Benjamin Applewhite thence along the said 19 Applewhite to the turn of the three Cretes thence along the said turn to the beginning together with all ways waters or water courses herewith belonging as all the estate right title thereto with all the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Benjamin Applewhite to his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Benjamin Applewhite his heirs and assigns forever and the said Rebecca Applewhite Henry Applewhite and Saml his wife for themselves their heirs &c. do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Benjamin Applewhite his heirs and assigns that they will warrant and defend the right and title of the above said tract or parcel of land against them and their heirs &c. and every other person whatever until the said Benjamin Applewhite and his heirs forever have run over our hands and seals this day and year above written signed sealed and delivered in presence of
