 Junior of Town of Boston and of South Hampton County and State of Virginia of the one part & Patrick
 Dolan of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said John Bayly do
 appear and for and consideration of the sum of Twelve hundred forty two dollars and seventy five
 cents to him in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Patrick Dolan at or before the exe-
 cution and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have bargained
 and sold and do by these presents bargain and sell unto the said Patrick Dolan his heirs
 and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southern
 part containing by value as now shown and used to be the same more or less and bounded
 in the following manner to wit Commencing at the main end of Fairfax branch also
 Corner to an Hered. Dolan's and Joseph C. Smith's line thence down the main run of
 said Fairfax branch following its various courses to the main run of the creek down
 thence up the main run of said Creek thence to Georg. Wilson and Samuel
 Whitfield's line thence along said Wilson and Whitfield's line an East Course to Herd
 Dolan's line thence along said Dolan's line to Fairfax branch to the beginning of
 with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging or in any way affect-
 ing and the revenue and reversions remainder and remainders of any other
 person and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold
 the said tract of Land with the tenements hereto annexed and all and singular
 other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold
 and every part and parcel thereof with every thing thereto in right or purchase
 or under the said Patrick Dolan his heirs and assigns forever and the said John Bayly
 Execution as aforesaid for himself and his heirs the said land with all and
 singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Patrick
 Dolan his heirs and assigns forever from the claim or claims of them the said John
 Bayly Senior as aforesaid and his heirs and of all and every person or persons who
 now shall or hereafter shall or lawfully defend. By these presents
