County of the third partake of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that the said
James B. Wilson and wife for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and four dollars and
seventy cent which said sum is due from the said James B. Wilson to the said Robert Murray by
bill of exchange date the 15th day of July 1825 as well as all other monies wht may be due and owing
from the said James B. Wilson and wife to the said Robert Murray by means of any dealing howe
of debt or paper whatever as also for any unconsidoration given dollar to them in hand paid by them
Walter G. Brattle to the receipt whereof the said James B. Wilson and wife doth fully acknowledge he
bargains and sois and by these presents doth fully grant bargaine and debt money and make over and
said Walter G. Brattle and his heirs forever all their right and interest in the following property thus
in my name known me ney woman now at home and her two children Easter and
the horse and one dog and a harring together with the present crop of Corn and Cotton belonging
to them the said James B. Wilson and wife to have and to hold well all the right and interest
of the said James B. Wilson and wife herein conveyed or intended to be conveyed to him by
the said Walter G. Brattle his heirs and assigns forever upon this special trust notwithstanding
that the said Walter G. Brattle upon being thereto required by the officers of the said Robert Murray
shall proceed to sell all the right and interest of the said James B. Wilson and wife to the above
named property being conveyed or intended to be conveyed after advertising the time and place in the
said County of Southampton for ten days previous at some publick house or store for Cash and
of the money arising out of from the said sale in the first place pay and satisfy all costs attending
the said sale as well as the expenses attending the said conveyance and then pay off the bond
agreed with intent as well as all other monies which may appear to be due and owing from the
