Know all men by these presents that I Benjamin L. Brown of the County of Southampton doth myself for these ten years to come to pay to John Hart of the County of Southampton the sum of one hundred dollars during his and his wife's life natural life but at either of their deaths the said John Brown and his wife shall be released from paying the above named one hundred dollars to him and his family bound to pay to the surviving one fifty dollars only annually during his or her natural life and at both their deaths this obligation is void and of no force or effect the said John Brown is further bound at any time when it shall appear that he is likely to spend his estate or sell it or most part of his estate so that the said John Hart and his wife may become Difficulties and shall be bound thenceforward to pay to him and his wife as much as shall be sufficient for his and his wife's support with good sufficient security But at the death of the said John Brown Death of his wife Polly Hart shall survive him and come forward and take her said part of a tract of land given to the said John Brown by a act of Sept or end of Sept so that the said Brown shall the benefit of any part of the temple of the said land then this obligation is entirely void and of no effect otherwise to remain in full force until both their deaths The limitation of the above obligation is such that whereas the said John Hart shall and will leave the said John Hart and his wife Polly with good and sufficient bond and pay them the said John Hart thirty dollars annually during his and his wife's life time and at either of their deaths pay to the surviving one fifteen dollars only annually then the above obligation is void and of no force otherwise infinite force and virtue given under my hand this 18<sup>th</sup> day of October 1825
