Know all men by these presents that I Benjamin L. Driver of the County of Hampshire

1822

do hereby certify that the said John Hart and his wife Polly Hart annually the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars during his and his personal estate for the natural life but at either of their deaths the said sum is to be paid and released from paying the above named sum this or her natural life and at both their deaths this obligation is void and of no force nor effect the said Driver is further bound at any time when it shall appear that he is willing to spend his estate or sell it for the purpose of making up to the said John Hart and his wife Polly Hart the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars during their lives or secure them for their support with good and sufficient security But at the death of the said John Hart or of his wife Polly Hart should survive him and come forward and take her third part of a Tract of land given to the said Driver by a deed of Gift or deed of Gift so that the said Driver should the benefit or any part of the benefit of the said land then this obligation is entirely void and of no effect otherwise to remain in full force and effect till both their deaths The limitation of the above obligation is such that whereas the said Driver and pay him the said sum of one hundred and twenty dollars annually during his and his wife's life time and at either of their deaths pay to the surviving or if neither survive only occasionally then the above obligation is void and of no force otherwise in full force and effect signed and sworn to my hand this 18th day of October 1824
