do hereby sell alienate and Confirm unto him the said Jacob Raines and his heirs
and assigns all my dower interest which I now or ever may hereafter have owned to the
land on which I now have the said dower interest being that which ascended to me from and by
the death of John Downum my former husband It have and to hold the said dower interest
and every part thereof unto him the said Jacob Raines and his heirs and assigns forever or during my other
thru as aforesaid and is the end of my own natural life during all which time and from the said
