 sideration of the sum of one thousand one hundred and thirty dollars to the said Sally Knight in hand paid by the
 said James Mayes at or before the selling and delivery of the present the receipt whereof the said Sally
 Knight doth or hath and therefore doth release and acquit and discharge the said James Mayes his
 Executors and administrators by these presents to the said Sally Knight having granted bargain sold
 alien and Conformed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien and Conform unto the said
 James Mayes and his heirs a certain piece or parcel of land situated lying and being in Southern
 part of the County of Virginia bounded as follows Beginning at a high water mark in the line of
 the beach road Corner William Hancock's line thence along the said road to the State line thence south
 along the said Road State line to a point Corner William Hancock's line and Alexander Davis's line
 to James Mayes's line thence along the said Davis's line to James Mayes's line thence along the
 Bay unto his line thence Corner of said James Mayes's and Clements Rochelle line thence back
 along said Rochelle line to a lightwood thence Corner thence along said Rochelle line to a

 her and to the said James Mayes and all heirs and assigns belonging or in any way
 concerning the same to have and to hold to the same her heirs conveyed and all and
 singular the other Chapman's heirs bargained and sold and every part & parcel
 thereof with their appurtenances unto the said James Mayes his heirs assigns
