County in the State of Virginia bounded as follows Beginning at a highwood tree in the head of
the ditch now Common Bore Run hence thence along the said road to the State line hence west
along the said Road State line to a pine Corner Nathan Pitts and Alexander Davis line
to Davis Bryant line thence along the said Davis line to Davis Bryant's line thence along the
Bryant line to three pines Corner of said Bryant's and Clements Rochelle line thence back
along said Rochelle line to lightwood stump Corner thence along said Rochelle line to a
tree with one branch cleaving along the meanderings of said branch to a corner
tree hence line then along the said line to the first tick standing all my best of trees
in State Virginia which fell to me by the death of my father and mother Edward &
