This Indenture made this 14<sup>th</sup> day of February on the year of our Lord Christ 1825  
 between Jacob Bradshaw of the County of Southampton State of Virginia and Plaintiff before  
 of the one part and Benjamin Bradshaw of the same County and State of Virginia part also before  
 that the said Jacob Bradshaw for and in consideration of the sum of forty eight dollars paid  
 And a half Acre of land in the County of Southampton State of Virginia part also before  
 the receipt whereof he said Jacob Bradshaw doth acknowledge himself fully and completely  
 and paid back granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and Conformed and by these presents doth  
 grant bargain and sell unto the said Benjamin Bradshaw to him and to his heirs forever  
 certain tract or parcel of Land and premises situated lying and being in the County of Southampton  
 aforesaid containing by a late Survey thirteen and one-half acres and bounded as follows First  
 Beginning at a tree oak a new corner made on Benjamin Bradshaw's land thence S 73° E 85  
 pole variation on the line thence N 82° W 106 pole or so thence due East 24 pole to a new  
 oak tree on the line of Benjamin Bradshaw and Jacob Bradshaw thence S 82° E 85 pole to a small pine  
 oak a new corner made between Benjamin and Jacob Bradshaw on the side of a small  
 branch thence along the said branch S 82° E 85 pole to a bay tree a new corner of said  
 Benjamin Bradshaw and Jacob Bradshaw in side of said Br. thence S 82° E 85 pole to a  
 large pine a new corner of Benjamin and Jacob Bradshaw thence due South 3 pole to the  
 first station together with all houses out houses Edifices buildings trees gardens orchardings  
 waters and water courses whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said  
 tract or parcel of Land and premises to have and to hold the same unto the said Benjamin  
 Bradshaw to him and to his heirs forever and the said Jacob Bradshaw for himself his  
 heirs and assigns doth by these presents Covenant and grant To and unto the said  
 Benjamin Bradshaw his heirs and assigns that he the said Jacob Bradshaw will warrant  
 forever defend all right title claims or demands of any person or persons claiming or main-  
 taining the same or any part or parcel thereof In witness whereof the said Jacob Bradshaw  
 hath huts set his hands and affixed his seal this day and date written

This Indenture made this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of July 1825 Between Benjamin Appleton and Mary his  
 wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Samuel James of the said County of the  
 other part, witnesseth that the said Benjamin Appleton and Mary his wife for and considera-  
 tion of the sum of four hundred and forty six dollars and Sixty five cents to them in hand  
 paid by the said Samuel James at a time the concluding and delivery of these presents  
 the receipt whereof the said Benjamin Appleton and Mary his wife doth hereby acknowledge  
 back granted bargained and sold aliened and Conformed and delivery these presents grant-  
 bargain sell alien and Conform unto the said Samuel James his heirs and assigns for  
 ever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton  
 Fifty two and a half acres he the same more or less it being a part of the land known to  
 Sammies and formerly known to him as follows to wit beginning at a tree above next to  
 an old branch thence a straight line to a maple a corner tree in the said line  
 thence down the branch to a pine tree in the said branch a corner in the said  
 line thence a straight line to a dead pine a corner in Edward Sommers line thence  
 straight line to a maple on the aforesaid branch thence up the said  
 branch to the beginning together with all water courses and water courses thereto  
 belonging as the estate to the said Samuel James his heirs and assigns forever
