Third Indenture made this 10<sup>th</sup> day of May 1825 by and between Newton Holland of Southern  
 ham County and State of Virginia of the first part and Frederick Holland of the same part of the  
 said County and State and Samuel Daugherty of the third part of the said County and State  
 Witnesseth that whereas the above named Newton Holland died on the second day of February  
 1825 leaving his heirs to William Currier for the sum of three hundred and no cents and no part  
 from the date with the above named Frederick Holland's debt to the said Newton Holland's estate  
 the said Frederick Holland is living and desired to indemnify the said Frederick Holland  
 from all and every expense whatsoever by this his Securityship but more especially for the sum  
 of one dollar in hand paid by the said Samuel Daugherty before the making and delivery of  
 these presents he shall grant and convey and sell and do by then present grant convey  
 and sell alien and assign to him the said Samuel Daugherty his heirs assigns  
 forever one tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County and State and  
 lower district of Southernhampton parish containing by late survey one hundred acres to the same  
 more or less with all its rights profits and emblements whatsoever at being the tract of  
 land the said Frederick Holland had by him Edward and Henry his wife to have and to hold  
 to him the said Samuel Daugherty his heirs and assigns shall quit to pay and do  
 that that is to say if the above named Frederick Holland shall fail to pay and do  
 the above debt or any part thereof so that the said Frederick Holland shall have
