This Indenture made the seventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty five. Between William Charles Barr, James and Benjamin Griffin Commissaries of the County Court to sell the lands that Ephraim Turner died seized of the one part and Matthew Williams of the other part with respect to and in consideration of the sum of one thousand thirty dollars twenty five Cents of lawful money of Virginia to be hereinafter paid (by goods and as is required by Law the bill at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) full granted bargained and sold and by these presents the said grant bargained and sold at Public Auction into the said Matthew Williams presently tract or parcel of Land lying and being on the County of Southampton and parish of St. Andrew's containing by Estimation thirty acres be the same more or less at any time the said Land that Ephraim Turner died seized subject to donor in the same and bounded as follows on the north by the Lands of Matthew Williams on the west by John Atterbury on the south by Anthony Wells and on the East by said Williams reference to the Parted Office being had and more fully expressed in the ^{committes} returns out thence and defines buildings Parcel Gardens ways moles and Curses profits, Tenements and appurtenances to the said Land belonging or in any way appertaining to the same or any part or parcel thereof. Do have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land unto the said Matthew Williams his heirs and assigns forever with and together the appurtenances the said Land belonging or in any way appertaining to the same or any part thereof and the said Williams James Barr James and Benjamin Griffin Commissaries as aforesaid for themselves their heirs the right and title which on them they do warrant and defend unto the said Matthew Williams his heirs assigns. In Testimony whereof the said Commissaries have hereunto set their hands and seals the day before first within written signed Sealed and delivered in presence of

This Indenture made and entered into on this 29th day of March the year our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty five by and between Joseph Pygum of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the first part and Charles Bryant of the same County and State of second part and Elizabeth Bryant of the same County and State of the third part Whereas the said Joseph Pygum stands partly indebted to the said Charles Bryant in sum of twenty five dollars forty four Cents due by him bearing even date with this indenture payable on demand the payment of which together with the interest which shall occur thereon the said Joseph Pygum are willing and desirous to secure effectually to appear and secure to the said Charles Bryant. Now Therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the said Joseph Pygum had on willing in consideration of the premises as of the sum of one dollar current money of the United States to him on hand paid by the said Elizabeth Bryant and before the underhand being delivery of these presents the full receipt whereof he acknowledged and from every part of which the said Elizabeth Bryant and all her legal representatives are forever released exonerated and discharged having to bargained and sold and fully grant and sell unto the said Elizabeth Bryant her heirs assigns as follows that is to say she said Joseph Pygum have granted and sold the following property First one Town the piece called on piece called one Walnut Chest one Iron one pair of casting bars and one on Spring wheel This is said by Fisher 1835 and hereafter to be held one pot one Spoon one Shovel one Warming Pan one and a piece of Carpenter and Cooper Tools and the balance of Henry pots and Kitchen furniture I have and to hold she said piece property named as aforesaid and all the right title interest and Estate whosoever of them
