This Indenture made this tenth day of January 1827 between Thomas Gray Alexander Briggs and wife Nancy Barnwell Bryant and wife Eliza and Joseph Somers and wife Polly in part and John Jones of the County of Southampton of the other part witnesseth that the said Thomas Gray Alexander Briggs and wife Nancy Barnwell P. Bryant and wife Eliza
Joseph Somers and wife Polly doth hereby acknowledge that they the said Thomas Gray
Alexander Briggs and Nancy his wife Barnwell P. Bryant and wife Eliza and
Joseph Somers and wife Polly have granted bargained and sold above sufficient and by themselves
doth grant bargain and sell above sufficient and Conformable to the Land John Jones
the same and appear forever a certain tract or parcels of land containing many eight
acres in the town or city of Norfolk being in the County of Norfolk and
bounded by the lands of Barnwell P. Bryant Esq. brother Confermee Jones and
Barney Eliza being the land wherein James Jones died formerly resided and sold
by him to his son Samuel Jones deceased and also all trees woods underwood Common
parcels profit to Barnwell his advantage Emoluments headements whatsoever to the
said tract of Land above mentioned belonging or in any wise affected among and after the
division or divisions remainder or unmeasured unto and service of the premises and of
every part and parcel thereof and also all the Estate right and title interest John Jones
whatsoever of the said Thomas Gray Alexander Briggs and wife Nancy Barnwell P.
Bryant and wife Eliza Somers and wife Polly in and to the said premises &
they part thereof to have and to hold all and singular the said premises above men-
tioned with every part and parcel thereof with its appurtenances unto the said John Jones
his heirs &c to the only person now and hereof of the said John Jones his heirs &c now
and the said Thomas Gray Alexander Briggs and wife Nancy Barnwell P. Bryant
and wife Eliza and Joseph Somers and wife Polly for them and their heirs his
part of Land and every part thereof agreed thereon and there has and agreement
all and every person whatsoever to the said John Jones his heirs &c of his
