Bryant and wife Mann do hereby covenome and warrant unto the said John Harris his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land containing ninety Eight Acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in the County of Sussex and bounded by the lands of Remond B. Bryant Esq. Father Conformance Heres and City Barren at being the land whereon James Town did formerly reside and sold by him to the said Samuel Jones dead and also all trees woods meadows common pastures profits Privileges advantages Emoluments hereditaments whatsover to the said tract of Land above mentioned belonging or on any ways offe obtaining and also the Messuages or messuages Tenements or tenements rent and Cornes of the premises and of every part and parcel thereof and also all the Right right and title wherunto claim Joyned whatsoever of the said Thomas Gray Alexander Briggs and wife Nancy Remond B. Bryant and wife Mann Social Sons and wife Polly in and to the said premises & every part thereof To have and to hold all and singular the said premises above mentioned with every part and parcel thereof with its appurtenances unto the said John Harris his heirs Ye to the only proper son and heire of the said John Harris his heirs Ye present and the said Thomas Gray Alexander Briggs and wife Nancy Remond B. Bryant and wife Mann for and for their Social Sons and wife Polly for them and their heirs the said Tract of Land and every part thereof against themselves and their heirs and assigns all and every person whatsoever to the said John Harris his heirs and assigns forever and well securement and Quiesse defered by their parents The within written of the said Thomas Gray Alexander Briggs and wife Nancy Remond B.
