These Indentures made and entered into this 28<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year of our Lord 1825 between John Washington of the first part Benjamin Griffin of the second part and Henry Leman of the third part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that the said John Washington for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars which said sum of money being due from the said John Washington to the said Henry Leman by bond bearing date the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1814 also for the further Consideration of the said Henry Leman being the said Washingtons attorney for the purchase of a tract of land sold by Commissioners for the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars account as all other monies which may be due and owing from the said John Washington to the said Henry Leman by means of any dealings whatsoever before or hitherto as also for the further Consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Benjamin Griffin the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and granted bargains and sales and by these presents doth fully grant bargain and sell convey and make over unto the said Benjamin Griffin and his heirs executors and administrators forever all his right and interest in the following property lying on tract of land and premises containing one acre and a half being and bounded by the road of James B. Weymouth charred by John J. Bailey and the said James B. Washington it being the tract of land of John Washington our son and property of and purchased by the said John B. Washington ~~John Weymouth~~ with all the right and interest of the said John B. Washington herein named or intended to be conveyed to the said Benjamin Griffin his heirs and assigns forever upon this special trust nevertheless that the said Benjamin Griffin upon being thereby required by the said Henry Leman to have or agree to have to sell all the right and interest of the said John B. Washington to the before mentioned tract of land having after advertising the time and place of sale in the said County of Southampton for buying a premises or some publick house or store for cash and out of the money arising from said sale in the first place and satisfying all costs as well as the expenses attending said conveyance and then pay to the said John Leman his heirs as agreed with the legal and just sum or value as well as all other monies which appear to be due and owing from the said John B. Washington to the said Henry Leman by means of any dealings whatsoever of debt or any security money Leman may lay or call on him or his and the sum of any pay to the said John B. Washington and the said John B. Washington shall for his heirs and assigns forever discharge warrant and defend against the lawful claim or claim of the said John B. Washington to his heirs executors administrators and assigns and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever and the said Benjamin Griffin on his part covenants and agrees he will make sale of the right and interest hereby granted for the best price he can obtain for the same after advertising the time and place for ten days at some publick house or store in the said County and with the monies arising from the sale pay the costs of the same together with the charge of conveying and then pay off the sum and interest as well as all other monies which may be due and owing from the said John B. Washington to the said Henry Leman by means of any dealings whatsoever or before whatsoever and then pay the sum of money to the said John B. Washington and the said Benjamin Griffin and agrees that he will release the said John B. Washington from the obligation of succumbance upon the said Washington paying him the amount of the aforesaid bond with interest as well as all other monies which may be due and owing to the said Henry Leman from the said John B. Washington by means of any dealings whatsoever of debt or pay or before whatsoever time thereof he passes to these presents have written set their hands and seals the day and year first written above and date of this instrument of reference
