the sum of five hundred and fifty dollars lawful money of Virginia to him in his hands due
to the said Thomas Joye at or before the ensing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
or hereby acknowledged have burgages and fees and by these presents doth burgage held and
said Thomas Joye his heirs &c a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in
County of Southampton and bounded on the East and North by the land of Thomas Applegate
on the south by the land of Andrew Gifford and on the West by the mill brook containing one hundred
fifty two acres to the same more or less to have and to hold the said aforesaid tract or parcel
land together with the appurtenances therunto belonging or in any way connected
pertaining to and for the use proper and benefit of him the said Thomas Joye his heirs &c
and the said Benjamin Joye and his heirs dech hereby convey said land with all and singular the
privileges and appurtenances before mentioned mentioned unto the said Thomas Joye his heirs &c for him
the claim or claims of him the said Benjamin Joye his heirs and of all and every person or persons
whatsoever shall use and do warrant forever before by these presents established to the said Thomas

This Indenture made this 15th day of March in the year of our Lord Christ 1821 between Robert Lindsey
Simmons and Elizabeth Simmons his wife both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and part
of attorney of the one part and Edwin Beck of the same County State and parish of the other part witnesseth
that the said Robert Lindsey Simmons and Elizabeth his wife for and consideration of the sum of Two
hundred and twenty nine dollars current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Edwin Beck the
receipt whereof the said Robert Lindsey Simmons and Elizabeth his wife doth acknowledge themselves fully and
satisfactorily paid have granted burgage and all other rights and Concessions and by these presents doth grant burg
age and all other rights and Concessions unto the said Edwin Beck to him and to his heirs forever to certain tract or parcel
of land and premises situate lying and being in the County State and parish of said tract containing
acres, to be the same more or less and bounded as follows truly beginning at the road on the land of the said
Benjamin Beck etc thence along that road to the branch called the village branch thence down the run of
said village branch to the low grounds to Stoney Parish at the village bridge and to the end of said
branch down the road aforesaid to the first station being the boundary line of the first tract and also the 1st
back containing forty six acres which to tract makes one hundred and thirteen & 1/2 acres back and
the 2nd tract bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a corner a surveying line between the
of Samuel Hells deo stone along that line to the Mill pond thence along the Mill pond the same line
to a Gun in Joshua and Thomas Phillips land thence along that line to the Mill pond again
thence along the run of the said Mill pond to the Spring branch thence along the run of
that branch to the first station together with all houses and lands thereabouts building
Garden orchard many waters and water courses in hollows belonging or in any way connected
unto to the said tract or parcel of land and premises to have and to hold the same and
said Edwin Beck to him and to his heirs forever and the said Robert Lindsey Simmons his
wife for themselves and their heirs forever doth by these presents covenant bind to do
and the said Joseph Beck his heirs and assigns that they will by these presents warrant of Heaven
all right title claim or demand of any person or persons claiming or demanding the same in any
or parcel thereof In witness whereof the said Robert Lindsey Simmons and Joseph Beck altho
wife and hereto set their hands and affixed their seals the day
