Auction on the land of John Johnson and the said Henry Seven became the purchasers for the consideration
of the sum of one hundred & twenty dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to have the said Patrick
Dow unburdened by the said Henry Seven at or before the mounting delivery of the premises the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by their premises being sold at publick
Auction unto the said Henry Seven his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing
by estimation seventy five and short thereabouts by the same manner of having the land owned by the
said John Johnson which he gave a due in trust to the said Dow for the benefit of the said Henry
