This Indenture made this 24th day of September in the year of Christ our Lord 1750 between Thomas Manfyn and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Kent in the County of Kent of the one part and John Thorpe of the County of Kent of the other part Wherefore it is shewed that the said Thomas Manfyn and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the hundred dollars Current money of Virginia to them in hand paid at or before the dateing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargain and sold and do by these presents bargain and sell unto the said John Thorpe his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract of land Containing one hundred forty two acres more or less lying situate and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows to wit on the North by the land of John Bickham on the East by the land of David Holbrook on the South by the land of John Jones and on the West by the land of John Bickham together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto in anywise belonging and jointly and severally unto the said John Thorpe his heirs and assigns according to have and to hold the said tract of land with its appurtenances to the said John Thorpe his heirs and assigns unto the said Thomas Manfyn and Elizabeth his wife for them selves and their heirs the aforesaid grants tract of land with all and singular the appurtenances as above mentioned unto the said John Thorpe his heirs and assigns free from the Claim or Claims of them the said Thomas Manfyn and Elizabeth his wife or either of them or either of their heirs and of all and of every person or persons or persons shall well and lawfully warrant and defend the said John Thorpe his heirs and assigns thereof they the said Thomas Manfyn and Elizabeth his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day & year above written

 Haven in the parish of said Town by November 23 Containing one half acre and bounded as follows
 To wit on the north end bounded by Shadrach Street on the west side bounded by John
 Lot on the east by Simon Dunsen lot and on the south end bounded by a lot owned
 by Clements Roschelle together with all and singular the appurtenances the same be
 long or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold the said Lot with all & singular
 the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Samuel Brown his heirs and assigns
 forever and the said William Hicks doth hereby solemnly swear he has executed the
