This Indenture made and executed this 19<sup>th</sup> day of October in the year of our Lord 1825 between Lewis C. Tregant and Rebecca his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and La Fayette Barrow of the County of Jerusalem of the other part all of the State of Virginia who hath and she doth hereby acknowledge and consideration of the sum of five hundred and fifty dollars current money of Virginia to them or her or paid by the said Lafayette Barrow the receipt whereof the said Lewis C. Tregant doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargain sold and conveyed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and convey unto the said La Fayette Barrow his heirs and assigns a certain lot or parcel of land containing five Acres and six quarters in the flat of the Town of Abasco on the Army of persons as doth 18<sup>th</sup> To have and to hold the said lot of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to have the said La Fayette Barrow his heirs and assigns forever and the said Lewis C. Tregant his heirs and assigns doth hereby Covenant and agree to and with the said Lafayette Barrow his heirs and assigns that the said Lewis C. Tregant and his heirs the said lot or parcel of land with its appurtenances unto the said Lafayette Barrow his heirs and assigns against whom the said Lewis C. Tregant his wife and their heirs and against all persons whomsoever shall and lawfully these presents in any warrant and defend. In witness whereof the said Lewis C. This Indenture made and entered into this day of November in the year of our Lord 1825 between Abraham Pope of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Joseph Pope of the same County and State of the other part all of the State of Virginia who hath and she doth hereby acknowledge and consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to them or her or paid by the said Joseph Pope as aforesaid the receipt and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargain and sold these by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Pope his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and State of Virginia and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a post on the corner of Thomas Brown and said Abraham Pope thence along a line of marked trees between the corner of Thomas Brown and said Abraham Pope near north east to the corner of the section of William Pope as a corner stump a corner of William Pope and said Abraham Pope and in Thomas Brown's line thence up the corner corner of said Abraham Pope and said Abraham Pope and said Abraham Pope near north east to a corner between William Pope & Abraham Pope and in Joseph Pope's line thence near South a line of marked trees between Joseph Pope and said Abraham Pope land to the first beginning containing by estimation thirty acres and one half of land together with all its appurtenances hereditaments and accessories and one half of land together with all its appurtenances or appurtenances and the receipt of
