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This Indenture made and executed this 19th day of October in the year of our Lord 1725 between Lewis C. Tregant and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Sir. Laphette Barron of the other part of the State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Lewis C. Tregant and wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars Current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Sir Laphette Barron, the receipt whereof the said Lewis C. Tregant doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted, conveyed, sold and conveyed and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Sir Laphette Barron his heirs and assigns a certain Lot or parcel of land containing Ten Acres and designated on the plan of the Town of Gloucester in the County of James as set forth 1718 To have and to hold the said lot of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Sir Laphette Barron his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Sir Laphette Barron his heirs and assigns forever and the said Lewis C. Tregant forborn of his heirs unto the said Sir Laphette Barron his heirs and assigns to and with the said Sir Laphette Barron his heirs and assigns that the said Lewis C. Tregant and his heirs the said lot or parcel of land with its appurtenances unto the said Sir Laphette Barron his heirs and assigns against them the said Lewis C. Tregant and wife and their heirs and against all persons whomsoever shall and lawfully their presents, assigns, heirs, executors and assigns. In witness whereof the said Lewis C. This indenture made and entered into this 7 day of November in the year of our Lord 1535 Between Blakmore Pope of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Joseph Pope of the same County and State of the other part Whose full shew the said Blakmore Pope for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Joseph Pope as a full and satisfying and delivery of their parents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold sold by their presents to the Virginia and sell unto the said Joseph Pope his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of lands situate lying and being in the famous County of Southampton and State of Virginia and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a post or stake corner tree of Thomas Town and said Blakmore Pope thence along a line of marked trees between the rivers of ~~the~~ James, James and said Blakmore Pope near north east to the run of the Indian Swamp is a corner stump a corner of William Pope and said Blakmore Pope and on Thomas Towns land thence up the various courses of said Swamp between William Pope and said Blakmore Pope near north west to a corner tree a black-burn a corner between William Pope and Blakmore Pope and on Trading Poles land thence near South a line of marked trees between Trading Poles and said Blakmore Pope thence to the first beginning containing by estimation thirty acres and one half of land together with all its Comitative Involvements hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land being appertaining and the record in of
