This Indenture made the 12th day of October 1525 between William Tuck of the first James Story of the same place and
 and James Bishop of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Whitherso that whereas
 the said William Tuck stands partly indebted to the aforesaid James Story by his bond bearing the same date
 with this indenture for the sum of the hundred and forty dollars and highly due and payable the 12th
 day of October 1525. And whereas the said William Tuck is willing to discharge of the said
 James Story the debt aforesaid. And this indenture further Whitherso that the said William
 Bishop at and before the sealing and delivery of this presents the receipt whereof hath and will
 come Tuck doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and by these presents doth grant
 bargain and sell unto the said James Bishop and to his heirs and assigns forever the follow-
 ing property to wit all the right title claim interest and demand of a certain tract of land
 called the Hilly place bounded by the said William Tuck Jacob Kings land and others
 containing two hundred acres more or less to and for the following use and purpose that to wit
 should the said William Tuck fail to pay punctually on the 12th day of October 1527 the
 sum within mentioned of the hundred and forty dollars and eight pence with the interest
 which shall have accrued thereon then in such case of failure the said James Bishop or his
 Executors or administrators may and shall at the request of either of the parties before mentioned
 sell at public sale duly giving thirty days notice all the right title claim interest &
 demand the said William Tuck has in or on the aforesaid tract of land for cash and
 out of the proceeds of said sale pay over to the aforesaid James Story the sum of two
 hundred and forty dollars and eight pence with the interest which shall have accrued thereon &
 costs attending this indenture and the balance if any pay over to the said William
 Tuck his heirs and assigns Whitherso whereof the parties have hereunto set their hands the 12th
 day of October 1525 signed sealed & acknowledged

This Indenture made and entered into this seventh day of October in the year of our Lord Jesus 1525 between Nathaniel
 Esqr. Executor of Matthew Jope dec'd of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Joseph Pope of the same
 County and State of the other part Whitherso that the said Nathaniel Esqr. Executor of Matthew Jope dec'd for and consideration of the
 sum of five hundred and thirty five dollars to him on hand paid by the said Joseph Pope at or before the sealing &
 delivery of this presents the full receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and to be by these presents
 bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Pope his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying
 and being in the County and State aforesaid and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a black Elm tree
 lying in a branch & corner the between Joseph Pope and said land and adjoining John Pope then Thomas
 near north a line of marked trees between the said land and John Pope to a pine a corner between said
 land and John Pope thence near west a line of marked trees between said land and John Pope
 land to a pine a corner between John Pope and said land and so Joseph Pope have thence near
 south a line of marked trees between said land and Joseph Pope to a corner between the between said
 land and Joseph Pope thence near East a line of marked trees between said land and Joseph Pope
 to the beginning containing thirty five and one third acres to the same more or less together
 with all its commodities emoluments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land
 belonging or appurtenant and the reversion and reversions remainder and remainors with
 and profits thereof to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and way past thereof
 unto the said Joseph Pope his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use & behoof
 of him the said Joseph Pope his heirs and assigns forever and the said Nathaniel Esqr. Executor
