This Indenture made and entered into this 28th day of November 1825 between William Evans of the first part and Henry Haley of the second part Witnesseth that the said Evans of the first part for and consideration of the sum of two hundred and two hundred dollars to him by the said Henry Haley and paid the receipt whereof a duly acknowledged hath given grants bargains and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said Henry Haley of the second part a certain tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia in the Fort of Mifflinham Swamp and Tragg, near Centerville by subdivision four hundred and forty four acres more or less being contiguous to the land of James Fort William Washington of his deceased father and John Washington as by them owned in and about the year 1813 being the same land which is conveyed in two tracts the one containing two hundred and forty acres the other three hundred four acres by deed executed on the 22 day of October in the year 1813 by William Washington and wife Joseph Washington Andrew Washington and others to William Evans which deed is of record in the Clerk's office of the County of Southampton and which deed is referred to for the boundaries and other designations of the said land To have and to hold the same to him if he hereafter and the said William Evans for himself his heirs and assigns by grants and defendants to the said Henry Haley his heirs and assigns full free and complete title to the said land to the full extent against the lawful claim or demand of himself his heirs his Mother Mary and his two sons John Barr or any future heirs and, either as to any right or claim in said part of the land or any part thereof or any interest therein and of all other persons.
