This Indenture made the day of October 1824 Between Robert Exm the debtor of the part first and William Ricks brother of the other part all of the County of Southampton Whereas the said Robert Exm is presently indebted to said John Exm the sum of one hundred and seventeen dollars & 25^{cts} in pursuance of a hearing date 1823 & 1824 which the said Robert Exm is willing and desirous to discharge and to pay the sum of one dollar by the said William Ricks he in hand paid to the said Robert Exm a sum before the delivery of them presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Robert Exm and he grants & releases & releases & confirms and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said William Ricks brother his heirs and assigns forever the following land & tenements lying on the side of St. Michaels ad joining the Bridge and bounded on the south by the Smithfield road on the north by Patrick Road and containing fifty acres more or less in or to all the interest right claim or demand of the above mentioned property to have and to hold the said Robert Exm intended to be granted the above land & tenements to the said William Ricks his heirs &c. for ever and the said Robert Exm for himself his heirs &c. hereby Covenant promises obliges to and with the said William Ricks his heirs &c. the above said land & tenements in manner following that is to say the said Robert Exm shall have &c. the above said land & tenements to the said William Ricks his heirs &c. against all persons whomsoever that and well covenant and defend by these presents upon trust nevertheless that the said William Ricks his heirs &c. shall permit the said Robert Exm to remain in quiet possession of the said land & tenements & take the profits thereof to the end that he should be made off the payment of the said sum of one hundred and seventeen dollars 25^{cts} in the whole or in part and then upon the further trust that the said John Exm his heirs &c. shall and will as soon after the happening of such default of payment as he shall think proper or the said John Exm his heirs &c. shall request sell the before mentioned land to the highest bidder for ready money at first like auction after first having given thirty days notice thereof to the Clerk of the County and as many other places as necessary and also giving the said Robert Exm timely notice of the day and place of sale and out of the money arising from said sale shall after satisfying the charges there of and all other expenses attending the sale to pay the said John Exm his heirs &c. the before mentioned sum of one hundred and seventeen dollars 25^{cts} with lawful interest there on and the balance of any payments Robert Exm his heirs &c. but if he paid whole of the above mentioned sum shall be fully paid off to the said Robert Exm his heirs &c. on or before the first day of January next after the same to be paid. And that no default of payment he made then this indenture to be void and the same to remain in full force & virtue to the witness where of the said parties have set their hands & seals the day & date first above written
