This Inventory made and entered into on this 12th day of December in the year of our Lord 1825 between
Jel Williams of the first part, Andrew Middleton of the second part and Lewis Monroe of the third part all of the
County of Southampton and State of Virginia Marshall that whereas the said Jel Williams deceased
justly indebted unto the said Lewis Monroe by his bearing arms and well known presents for the sum
of one hundred dollars the payment whereof together with the interest thereon shall accrue him
the said Jel Williams is willing and desirous effectually to agree and consent to the said
Lewis Monroe & his executors administrators that the said Jel Williams as before mentioned
entitled to the premises as of the sum of one dollar to have a claim paid by the said Andrew
Middleton as or before the meeting and delivery of these presents (the full receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged) have granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargained
sell unto the said Andrew Middleton his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land late
lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke Containing
Eighty acres more or less at being last at & still to the said Jel Williams of the lands of John
Williams and his further as will appear by the Compt of Surveys report on the survey
of said described land and bounded as follows: That is to say Beginning at a point a corner
of the inner land of Jel Williams and the land of Henry Bryant in Southwicks Run thence along
said Jel Williams' outer land to a corner of lot No 3 drawn by Miles Williams thence to a
corner of lot No 2 drawn by William Whifield in Southwicks Run to a corner land thence to a corner of
Dowry Bryant thence along said Bryant's land to the beginning of above outer certain tract or parcel
of land situated as aforesaid which is the said Jel Williams purchase of the land of John Williams
and Stacey his wife as will appear on record of being lot No 3 allotted to said Miles Williams by the said
Commissioners as will also appear by the said report containing one hundred acres more or less and bounded
