one hundred dollars together with the interest which shall accrue thereon in before the said Lewis Morell
or his legal representatives shall or may require demand the same than this and herein and every thing
herein contained is to be void and of none effect but of otherwise than the said John Middleton informed
against or writing from either of the said Jas. Williams or his legal representatives or of the said Jas.
Williams or his legal representatives shall and may sell and dispose of all the said lands required
properly or so much thereof as will be sufficient to pay and satisfy the aforesaid debt or sum of
money with the legal interest thereon accruing at publick auction on the premises for ready money
by giving ten days previous publick notice of the time and place of such sale by advertisement
posted up in at least three different publick places in said County and out of the proceeds of such
sale after paying all Costs and charges attending the execution of these presents pay unto the said
Lewis Morell the aforesaid sum of one hundred dollars with the interest thereon so much
as may be then due and the one plus of any sum or sums remaining on the hand of said John
Middleton is to be paid over to the said Jas. Williams or his order or agents In case any
part of the said land negro or property should remain unpaid at the time of the payment
of said debt or sum of money and as the intent theron be the said John Middleton is to be
reduced to the said Jas. Williams all title therein hereby Conveyed to him and unless the said
John Middleton shall see before the execution of this trust his testate intention dare to carry
this indenture into effect and operation and the said Jas. Williams for himself his heirs
executors administrators and assigns hereby do make to and with the said John Middleton
his heirs executors and assigns that the aforesaid tract of Land negro and property are free & clear from
the claim or demand of all and every person or persons whatsoever and will by their present covenant of
forever defend the right title of the same and every part thereof unto him the said John
Middleton his heirs executors and assigns forever.

This Indenture made and executed this 15 day of December in the year of our Lord 1825 Between Thomas
Ritter Jr. of the County of Bluffton of the first part William Dolan of the said County of the second
part and Patrick Dolan who is commonly known as Trustee of the said County of the third part
Witnessed that whereas the said Thomas Ritter Jr. of the first part party aforesaid unto the said William
Dolan in the sum of one hundred fifty dollars due the 27th day of March 1816 and the said
Thomas Ritter being willing and desirous to secure the said William Dolan on the aforesaid debt &
interest as aforesaid by these presents give grant bargain and sell make over and confirm unto
the said Patrick Dolan as trustee aforesaid the following property located on certain tract or parcels
of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid containing thereby acres to the same more
or less and adjoining the land of John Womble deceased late of the said Township and upon
which the said Thomas Ritter now resides also the following property then bed of River
in pots on Ritter's on property for one mile from one mile Taylor's bridge on hominy
Mountain one East & West rods of all kinds of farm ing interests and one half acre of land to the
said the said property unto him the said Patrick Dolan as trustee aforesaid aforesaid
