This Indenture made this ninth day of December on the year of our Lord 1825 between Benjamin Myrick and Ann his wife of the County of Brunswick of the first part and Thomas Applewhite of the County of Southampton of the second part testifies that the said Benjamin Myrick and Ann his wife for and on consideration of the sum of Five hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Applewhite at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Benjamin Myrick and Ann his wife have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Applewhite his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton containing two hundred and thirty seven acres more or less and bounded by the three Quarts in the East and the Land of Alexander P. Pale John Bures and the Estate of Richard Johnson dec'd. To Have and to Hold the said tract or parcel of Land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto in and to the said Thomas Applewhite his heirs and assigns forever and singular the appurtenances thereto in and to the said Thomas Applewhite his heirs and assigns forever and the said Benjamin Myrick and Ann his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract or parcel of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances unto the said Thomas Applewhite his heirs and assigns forever from the claim or claims of them the said Benjamin Myrick and Ann his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever that will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents to and to the heirs of the said Benjamin Myrick and Ann his wife their heirs and assigns their heirs the day and year being first above written
