This Indenture made and executed this 15th day of January Anno domini one thousand eight hundred and twenty six between William J. J. of the County of Southampton of the first part Elliott Whitehead and Edgar Whitehead of the County of Suffolk and County of Kent of the second part and Jarrett Judkins of the County of Southampton of the third part all the parties residing in the State of Virginia &c. mutually covenants by the parties as their brothers of the third part all the parties residing in the State of Virginia &c. that the said Jarrett Judkins do and assignation of the sum of five hundred dollars Current money which the said Jarrett Judkins do hereby indite unto them the said Elliott Whitehead and Edgar Whitehead by writings under his hand and seal Commonly called Single Bills bearing date with these presents payable on demand one to Elliott Whitehead for three hundred dollars the other to Edgar Whitehead for two hundred dollars and the said Jarrett Judkins for the sum payable of the same being in satisfaction of the sum of five hundred dollars Current money as aforesaid and for the further Consideration of the part and full sum of one dollar to him the said Jarrett Judkins on hand paid by him the said Jarrett Judkins at or before the execution and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof the said Jarrett Judkins do hereby acknowledge and of being paid thereof do the receipt & discharge him the said Jarrett Judkins his heirs and assigns forever he the said Jarrett Judkins hath granted, bargained and sold, aliened, enfeoffed and Conveyed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff and Convey unto the said Jarrett Judkins his heirs and assigns forever two thirds of a certain tract, piece or parcel of Land situate, lying and being in the County of Southampton Containing by estimation one hundred and eighty six and three quarters acres more or less and bounded by the land of Russell Bryant William Hudson the land of the late John Bond the late Benjamin Grays land and Joseph Gray and others and is two thirds of the same tract, piece or parcel of land which the said Jarrett Judkins do hereby sell to by deed of bargain and sale from the said Elliott and Edgar Whitehead bearing date the day of January 1826 duly acknowledged and recorded in the Clerk's Office of Southampton on the day now with these presents also one other small tract piece or parcel of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid and Containing by estimation one acre more or less and bounded by the land of Patsy Chandler Russell Bryant and the said Bond above described and is the same tract piece or parcel of Land which the said Jarrett Judkins do hereby sell to by deed from William Bryant John Whitehead & William Thibault
