 of the one part and El. Joppin of the other part Witnesseth that the said Tobias Thompson in consideration  
 of the sum of five hundred lawful money of the Commonwealth to have in hand paid by the said El.  
 Joppin at & before the executing and delivery of their presents (the excepted sum of five hundred  
 shillings bargain and sold and by their presents so bargain and sell unto the said El. Joppin  
 the said and assigns a certain tract of Land containing one hundred and fifty acres more or less  
 as joining the Land of the said El. Joppin Council Thomas and Thomas and Thomas and Thomas  
 together with all and singular the appurtenances and the said reversions and reversions and  
 remainders yearly and other rents fees and profits thereof and of every part and parcel  
 thereof with every of her rights members and appurtenances unto the said El. Joppin his heirs  
 and for and during my natural life and the said Tobias Thompson himself and his heirs  
 the said one hundred and fifty acres of Land more or less with all and singular the premises
