This Indenture made this 22nd day of January in the year of our Lord 1816 Between Elias Carter and his
 wife of the one part and Samuel Corbett Jr. of the other part all of the County of Donhampton part of the
 way and State of Virginia Witnesses that the said Elias Carter and Samuel his wife recommended to
 the favor of our Hundred and thirty five dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to them and
 paid by the said Samuel Corbett Jr. at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of
 them doth bargain and sell unto the said Samuel Corbett his heirs and assigns a certain tract
 or parcel of Land containing by Estimation forty two acres in the same more or less and bounded
 on the west by the lands of Peter Wray on the south by Black water River on the east by the
 lands of Samuel Corbett Jr. and on the north by the said Black water River being the Land that
 John Carter proclaims of whom see reference to the Clerk's Office being the said more fully
 appear together with all appurtenances the same and hereto regard. And we do hereby warrant
 and agree to defend the said Samuel Corbett his heirs and assigns forever and the said
 Frederick S. Mahone and appurtenances hereto against the said Samuel Corbett his heirs and assigns
 appurtenances to the said one third part or parcel thereof To Have and to hold the said
 one third part or parcel of Land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Frederick S. Mahone
 his heirs and assigns forever and against all persons whomsoever that will of do by their parents
 former covenant and defend In Witness whereof the said Samuel Corbett his heirs and assigns
 into the said Samuel Corbett his heirs and assigns forever and for the only proper use
